Performer's Call Time: Plan to be in your assigned seats no later than 6:45 p.m.

Concert Dress: Performers should wear any combination of *black and white dressy* holiday clothes with optional touches of red. Dress shoes are required for everyone. No large rings or bracelets. No jeans, bare midriffs, short mini skirts or immodest clothing.

Tickets: Tickets will be available at the door before the performance. Tickets will also be sold during rehearsals on Friday Nov. 18 and Saturday Nov. 19. Tickets are \$10 for everyone. Performers do not need a ticket. Since the performance will be 1 ½ to 2 hours in length, it is not recommended for very young children or babies. Students should plan to stay for the entire performance except for emergencies.

Photography and Video: No flash photography during the performance please, and video cameras are limited to the balcony.

Arrival for Rehearsals: Please arrive **15 minutes** before the start of your rehearsal so that you may receive any last minute instructions/changes from the monitor, then line up and be ready to move into place immediately after the previous rehearsal group exits. *Parents are not allowed inside the rehearsal rooms during rehearsals.*

November 11 and 12 rehearsals at Boulder Piano Gallery: located at 3111 Walnut St,. Boulder ` (on the east side of 30th Street).

November 18 and 19 rehearsals/performance at Skyline High School: 600 E. Mountain Ave, Longmont. Rehearsals will take place on stage and in the band room.

Food or Drink: No food, drink, or chewing gum is allowed at any of the rehearsals or at the concert.

Be very respectful of the instruments: Do not place ANYTHING on the pianos except the music you are playing at the time. Pencils, paper clips, bags, coats, anything with zippers or buttons etc, and music that is not being used at the moment should be kept on the floor. *These are very beautiful and extremely valuable pianos* and we want to be very careful not to damage them. Pianos and digital keyboards are provided by Schmitt Music, Boulder Piano Gallery and Rockley's Music.

Student Announcers: Each piece will be introduced by a student performer and should be limited to about 30 seconds in length. If you have been selected to announce a piece, please do some research (with your teacher, parents, or on your own) to create a short introduction for your piece. Your script may include information about the composer or arranger, or an interesting story about the history of the piece or how the piece came to be composed or became popular, or its meaning to the composer or listener. Please rehearse your speech with your teacher.
