- ◆ Length: up to 10 minutes
- ◆ Composed between January 1, 2018 - January 31, 2019
- ◆ Multiple submissions accepted
- ◆ Composers are encouraged to perform their own pieces. The Rocky Mountain Composers can provide performers for piano, flute, viola, and electric bass. Entrants will be responsible for providing any additional instrumentalists for performances of their submissions.

Submission Format/Recording:

- ◆ Scores may be written by hand, scanned and submitted as a PDF, or rendered as PDF by music writing software (preferred).  
noteflight.com provides free cloud-based music notation via web browser, and musescore.org offers free downloads of its full-featured software.
- ◆ A live recording of the piece is preferred in mp3 format.
