Brenna Berman holds an Associate Faculty position with The Golandsky Institute and has seventeen years of training as a performer and teacher of the Taubman Approach. The Taubman Approach was discovered by Dorothy Taubman (and further developed by Edna Golandsky and others) to promote virtuosity, eliminate pain, and solve technical and musical difficulties. It incorporates a thorough understanding and mastery of coordinated movement at the keyboard, giving the pianist the ability to reliably create the desired accuracy and musical effect. Ms. Berman became a Certified Instructor of the Taubman Approach with The Golandsky Institute in 2006 and was certified at the Associate level in 2009.

Please also note that both the March meeting on Friday, March 17 (St. Patrick's Day!) AND the Taubman lecture/demonstration which will follow the meeting will be in Brenna's home studio, 112 Aline Street in Louisville, 80027 **and will only be offered LIVE. NO ZOOM!** (Don't forget to wear something green!)!

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
