Treasurer Report: Jill Ice	 Checking \$13,381.17 Savings \$6,323.52 The checking account does not reflect the \$5,070 check that was written to SVVSD for MPF. So more accurately we have just over \$8,000 in checking. We paid \$1,825 to Richard Capp to replace the bass strings on the BAMTA piano. This price also includes several tunings over the next six months. I deposited the \$500 check from the Bobby Niebauer Trust and \$45 for two membership renewals. MPF had a net loss of \$187.94.
