Event description

This event is an opportunity to recognize students' talent and achievement in their music study, and it is open to students of all levels and all ages.

Each student performs two solo pieces (one of them must be memorized) and minimum two options. Upon completion, all students receive comments from adjudicators on their performances and options, certificates, and ribbons for participation.

The students can choose to be super-achiever candidates. To do so, students must complete four options, including at least one from A. Technique option and one from B. Musical knowledge option. Those who perform at a satisfactory level in solo pieces and all options, with a score 80% or higher in B option, receive super-achiever medals.

There is a preparatory level, and level 1 through 12.
