

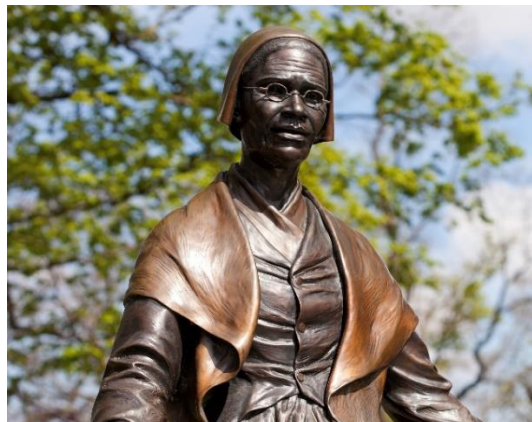
ASTER Women's Chamber Choir
