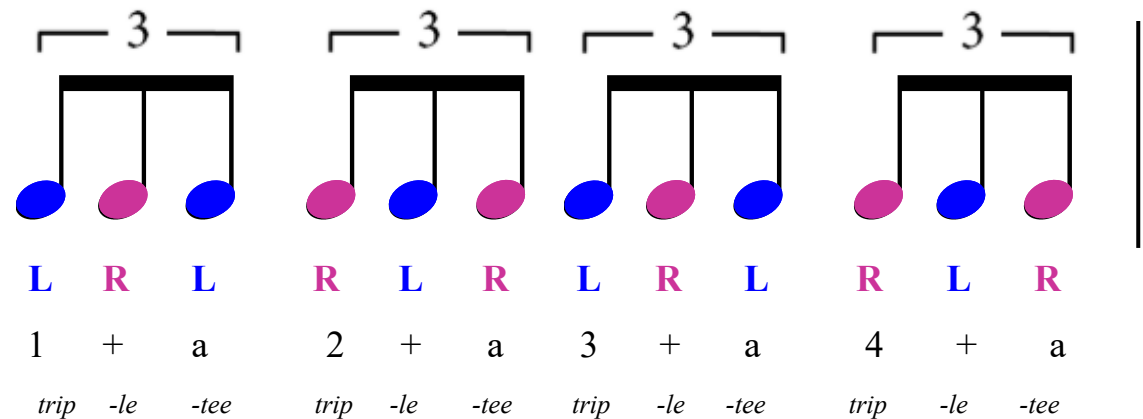

Golden: *This is part of a Medley. We are using m.83 to the end (p.8 - p.15)*

- *TYPOs in the PRIMO:*

(Observe RH 8vas for the rest of that section as indicated)

- SECONDO: do not play the glissando at the very beginning or very end (m.83 & m.169)

- Add pedal - pedal harmonically

- PRIMO - m.144, beat 2, LH - drop the notes on this beat (it is doubling Secondo's notes). Instead, it is suggested to split the RH's D octave between the hands for ease of playing.

-- m. 122: LH drop the grace note - it's really awkward to play.

GENERAL DYNAMICS (there will be a lot of dynamic shaping within these):

m. 83 (beginning): Primo= *mp*, Secondo= *p*

m. 91: Primo= *p*, Secondo= *mf*

m. 99: Primo= *mf*, Secondo= *mp*

m. 107: Primo= *p*, Secondo= *mp*

m. 111: Secondo= *mf*

- Please work off of the included copies of the Shostakovich Waltz #2 (see the last pages of this file). I've changed, fixed and reworked a lot of the typos, mistakes, doubled notes, 8vas, and also redistributed notes for the Primo in a couple of sections. I've also included a few more dynamics and a couple of rit.s in this copy.

- This is not the most pedagogically sound arrangement by any means (but it still is a really great piece!). I completely understand if students need to drop notes from octave chords, 4-note chords, jump chords, etc. Please feel free to adapt within reason to make it accessible for your students. Also, feel free to re-distribute more notes between the hands.

SECONDOS-

- m.29-31, etc.: It is suggested to take the bass clef chords on count #1 with the RH, and then have the LH play the chords on counts #2 & #3.

In m.31, etc., on count #1, RH can drop the Eb for that beat if that is helpful at this quick tempo.

- Add light pedal throughout if you'd like. This is a general guide (use your ear to not "muddy" up the sound):

-- m.1-27, 59-61, etc.: clear on beat #1

-- m. 28-42 and m.43-58, etc.: pedal down on beat #1 and up on beat #2 (no pedal on beat #3)

-- m. 79-107: clear on beat #1, but on m.81,82, etc. clear the pedal more often - listen to the Primo melody

-- m.108-110, 143: clear each beat

- m. 110, 111, 112, secondo may wish to cross over with LH and play the A-Eb fifth.
- m. 112-113: tenuto beat 3 (112) and beat 1 (113)
- m. 114 and following: legato
- m. 129: DHN=58
- m. 153: a tempo (DHN=63)
- m. 159: primo, RH, beat 1 should be Eb, not E double flat.
- m. 161-162: primo, legato
- m. 163-164: secondo, legato
- m. 165, secondo, RH beat 1 is an F#.
- m. 168: ritard; a tempo, m. 169
- m. 170, secondo may choose to play RH beat 3 as G-Bb (taking the G from the LH). This is the same as m. 172.
- m. 184: primo RH remains 8va through beat 1 of m. 185.
- m. 192, primo may choose to play beat 3 with RH. It makes the transition to m. 193 easier for both hands.
- m. 201: Tempo change to Animato, DHN=72
- m. 210: primo, play the Eb as an octave, no grace note, *pp*.

There are also measures where playing octaves could be optional. As written, they may not be easy to execute at tempo: m. 149, 151 secondo LH; m. 199-200, primo RH; m. 206-208 secondo LH.

There are quite a few typos in the PRIMO part. Here is the list of what to fix. You can also look at the following pages to see where the fixes are (the affected pages are attached here and the "fixes" are highlighted in green).

By the way, the title Dance "Marabre" is also a typo in case you overlooked that! Haha!

PRIMO:

- Page 3, **LH**, m. 41 - 45 (m. 45 count #1 only): LH play 15ma higher so that your LH is only one octave lower than the RH.
- Page 8, **RH**, m. 127: RH play B NATURAL on count #1.
- Page 8, **RH & LH**, m. 135: play F SHARPS on count #3 (cross out the natural signs) for both hands.
- Page 10, **RH**, m. 158 - 165 (m. 165 count #1 only): RH play 8va
- Page 10, **RH**, m. 160: RH play F NATURAL on count "2+" (just like count 3+).
- Page 10, **RH**, m. 168 (starting on count "2+"): RH play 8va.
- Page 11, **RH**, continue playing RH 8va from m. 169 through beat #1 of m. 185 (beats 2 & 3 are Loco)
- Page 13, **LH**, m. 204-205: play LH one octave LOWER for these measures.
- Page 13, **RH**, m. 210: RH play 8va.

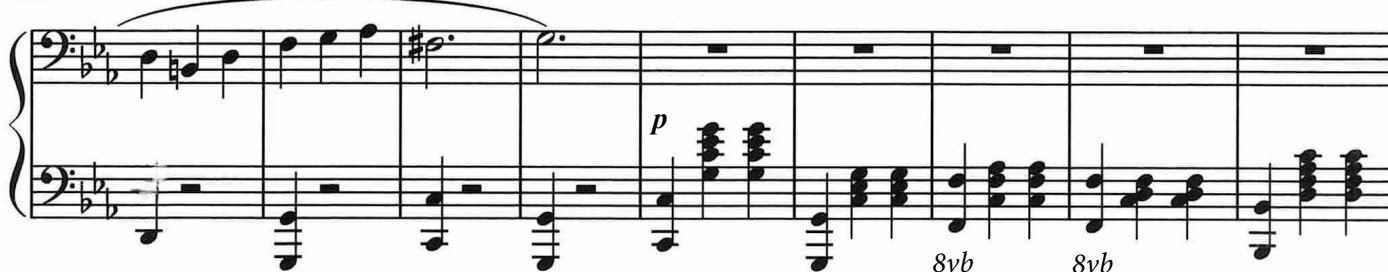

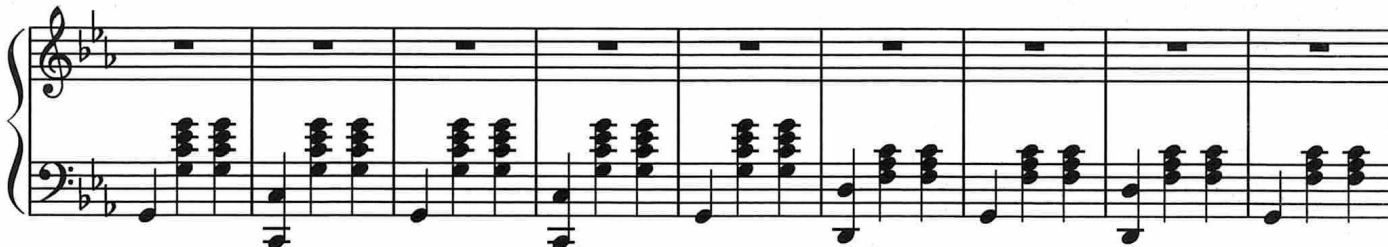
